

## Waste Only Tote (Grey)

- **Pickup will remain on your regular scheduled day.** See calendar at <http://www.stettler.net/public/data/documents/GarbageCollection2018pdf.pdf> for pick up schedule.
- Place your bagged and tied household garbage in your **GREY** waste tote. The lid must be closed.
- Styrofoam must go in your **GREY** waste tote.



## Recycle bin (Green)

- **Pickup will remain on your regular scheduled day.**
- See calendar at <http://www.stettler.net/public/data/documents/GarbageCollection2018pdf.pdf> for pick up schedule.
- Items must be placed **LOOSELY** into the bin.
- Any questions regarding acceptable items, please call **Can Pak Environmental at 403-747-3456.**
- **Composting remains the same.**



## Please Recycle the Following

### Green bin

- **Metal cans & tins** - Empty, rinse & remove labels and lids; or leave lids attached and trapped inside. Aluminum containers, pie plates.
- **Plastic Containers** (1-7) Empty & Rinse, detergent, household cleaner bottles, pop & beverage bottles, milk jugs, plastic bags (put together in one bag), margarine & yogurt containers.
- **Paper** - Newspaper & inserts, magazines, catalogues, white writing & computer paper, greeting cards, non-foil gift wrap, junk mail, paper bags, envelopes, paper egg cartons, paperback and hard cover books, phone books.  
**\*\*Shredded paper is only accepted if in clear plastic bags\*\***
- **Cardboard** - Flattened corrugated cardboard and shoe boxes (when flattened, must be no longer than 36 sq inches. Flatten cereal & food boxes (remove and discard liner)

### What is NOT Accepted for recycling:

- Any Glass items (including pickle/jam jars, beverage bottles, etc) due to cut hazard
- Waxed cardboard
- Used paper towels or tissues
- Ceramics, china, glass plates, light bulbs or mirrors
- Tupperware or similar type containers
- Styrofoam packaging of any kind
- Plumbing pipe (PVC)
- Clothing or shoes
- Hypodermic needles/syringes or medical supplies
- No items made of more than one material
- No liquids of any kind (ie. motor oils, cooking oils, paint, etc.)

## Taking Care of your Totes

- You are responsible for taking care of your totes and keeping them clean.
- If your tote is damaged or missing, call **Can Pak Environmental at 403-747-3456.**

### Identify your totes

- Record your serial numbers and keep it somewhere safe.
- Write your address on the inside of the tote lid with a permanent marker. This will help identify your totes if they ever go missing or need repairs.
- Do NOT put your name on the totes as they are assigned to this specific address.
- Call **Can Pak Environmental at 403-747-3456** if you have questions regarding your waste and recycling totes.

### If you move...

- Please do not take your totes with you. They remain the property of Can Pak Environmental and are assigned to residences rather than people.
- If you move to a residence that does not have a tote, please call **Town of Stettler at 403-742-8305** or email [townoffice@stettler.net](mailto:townoffice@stettler.net) for any new account set up, or billing inquiries.

## What to do on Collection Day

### Set them out by 8am

#### Point them

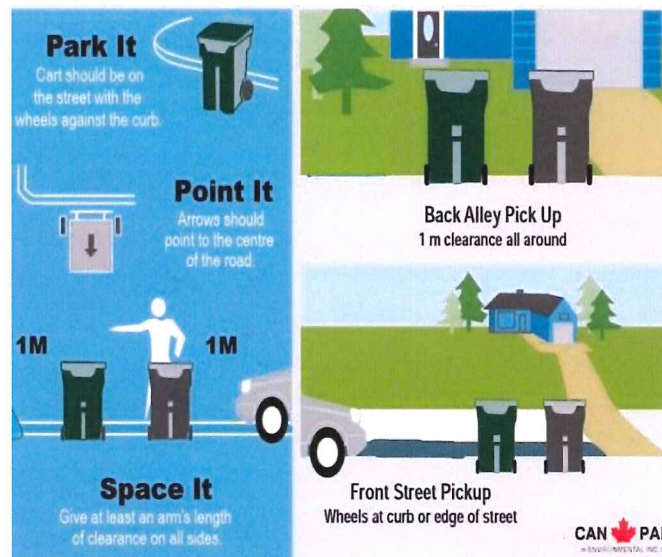
- Place your totes so the arrow on the lid points towards the center of the street/alley way.
- Place wheels at curb or edge of street/alley.
- No items or bags placed beside the grey tote will be collected.

#### Space Them

- Space your totes so that there is at least 1 meter (3ft) of space between your totes and other objects (e.g. parked cars, power poles, utility boxes, fences).
- Leave 3 meters (10 ft) of space above the totes. If totes are placed underneath a tree, overhang or power line they cannot be collected safely.

#### Remove Them

- Totes should be returned to an area nearest the residence no later than 7pm on the day of collection, and stored in such a way as to protect them from wind or other damage.



## What **NOT** to do on Collection Day

- Do NOT overfill your totes. Please make sure the lid is completely closed.
- Do NOT place tote on the sidewalk.
- Do NOT put these items in your totes:
  - NO propane tanks or cylinders
  - NO automobile tires
  - NO lead-acid batteries
  - NO paints, solvents or any liquids
  - NO hazardous materials
  - NO gypsum (drywall)
  - NO animal carcasses
  - NO used oil or oil filters
  - NO TVs or computer monitors
  - No Grass Clippings (place in compost bins only)
