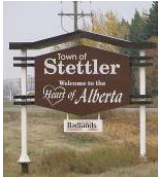

### **Remembrance Day Service**

There will be a Remembrance Day Service on **FRIDAY, NOVEMBER 11, 2011** at the Performing Arts Centre in Stettler at **11:00 a.m.** with assembly at 10:30 a.m. followed by a social and luncheon at the Legion Hall located at 5012 – 51 Street.

### **Sidewalk Snow Removal Policy**

The Town of Stettler revised the Sidewalk Snow Removal Policy in April. The two major changes are:

1. The Town has set priorities for snow removal on sidewalks and pathways. Priority 2 and 3 sidewalks/pathways may not be cleared for a couple of days during the heavy snowfall conditions.
2. The Town will be clearing sidewalks that are adjacent to Town owned properties only. Portions of sidewalk used to be cleared along residential properties, however those sections will now be the responsibility of the adjacent property owner. Letters will be sent out to the affected property owners. The Town will still remove snow from all pathways.
