Dog Park Off-Leash Code of Conduct

Please obey this code at the Dog Park and encourage others to do the same:

- Open Dawn till Dusk Daily.
- Leash your dog(s) while entering and exiting the dog off-leash area.
- Dog(s) may be unleashed inside the compound.
- Dog owners are responsible for their dog's behavior.
- Dog owners must maintain control of their dogs at all times.
- Dog owners are responsible for the safe disposal of dog waste; use bags from the dispensers and place in garbage.
- Leash your dog(s) if it exhibits aggressive behavior towards other dogs or users.
- Do not let children run unattended in the dog off-leash area.
- Do not bring female dogs in heat into the dog off-leash area.
- Do not allow dogs to dig holes.
- Do not bring other types of animals into the dog off-leash area.
