

ARE YOU RAISING YOUR OWN MOSQUITOS?

There are many cases where homeowners are contributing to the mosquito population. It takes very little water to breed hundreds of mosquitos. Please go through the list below and see how you can help to control the population of mosquitos in the Town of Stettler.

Rain Gutters: Clogged rain gutters can hold enough water to produce mosquitos.

Swimming Pools: A swimming pool is large enough to produce enough mosquitos for a whole neighbourhood. Keep your pool free of debris. Keep water clean and chlorinated.

Tires: Store tires in a shed or indoors. If left outside, drill holes in them to drain water.

Flower Pots: Pots with dishes under them can hold enough water to produce mosquitos.

Bird Baths: Keep free of Debris and change water at least once a week.

Garbage & Recycling Cans: Cut holes in the very bottom to allow for drainage.

Tarps: Always keep tarps tight and drain excess water.

Standing Water: Eliminate by draining or filling.

Others: Buckets, cans, covers, etc.
