Re: Coronavirus - Precautions Taken by White Sands Village Council

With the potential spread of the Corona virus, Village Council is taking precautions to ensure all our residents are protected from the spread of COVID-19. As such we have taken the following steps:

1. The Community Hall will be closed for all activities until further notice.
2. The Take It or Leave It Shed has been closed until further notice.
3. Water Station - we ask that those using the water station, take hand sanitizer or disinfectant to clean any areas you touch to ensure the water source and hoses remain uninfected. We are working on a solution to have sanitizer at the sight.
4. Many of our residents have or are returning from winter vacations and are or will be self quarantining for the recommended 14 days (as prescribed by Alberta Health Services). Others who may feel ill or experience symptoms related to the Coronavirus will also be self quarantining.
