The discounted cost for Dog and Cat Licenses purchased on or before January 31, 2020 is \$15.00 for spayed or neutered animals and \$40.00 for unaltered animals. 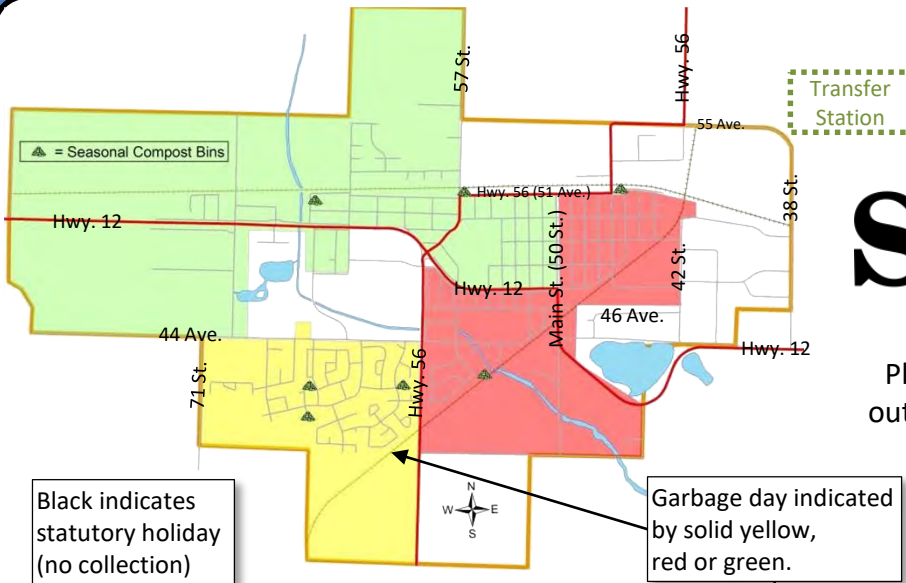

Year-Round Toxic Waste Collection!

Some items that are accepted at the Stettler Eco Centre:

- paints
- household batteries (please tape terminals)
 - fluorescent bulbs/tubes
 - inkjets, laser toners,
- cell phones and small electronics
- paint thinners/strippers
 - liquid cleaners
 - weed killers
 - bleach
 - ballasts
 - ammonia
- cigarette lighters
 - detergents
 - glues
- hair colouring
 - herbicide
 - fungicide
 - fertilizer
 - pesticide
 - roofing tar
 - degreaser

Metals (rinse, remove or trap ends):

- aluminum cans
- aluminum containers (pie plates)

Cardboard:

- flatten cardboard boxes (remove styrofoam and/or plastic)
- milk cartons (remove cap, rinse with water + flatten)
- juice boxes (remove straw)

Plastics (remove lids, empty + rinse, labels can be left on):

- beverage containers (milk jugs + pop bottles)
- condiment containers (ketchup, peanut butter, etc.)
- detergent + fabric softener bottles
- household cleaner bottles
- plastic bags (put together in one bag)
- yogurt containers

Paper:

- catalogues + magazines
- computer paper
- envelopes
- greeting cards + non-foil gift wrap
- paperback + hardcover books
- paper bags
- paper egg cartons
- phonebooks
- shredded paper (only accepted in clear plastic bags)
- newspapers, insert and junk mail
