♥ 2010 Water & Garbage Rate Increase ♥

To address cost increases identified in the Town's 2010 utility budget process, Town Council has considered it necessary to modestly increase some of the user rates associated with the supply of municipal utility services to Stettler residents. Municipal rates and charges effective with the first billing period in 2010 will be as follows:

- Water variable charges \$1.77 m^3 (increased from \$1.70 m^3); 1 m^3 = 220 gallons
- Water fixed distribution charge \$10.00 per month (no change)
- Residential Sewer flat charges \$14.00 per month (no change)
- Commercial sewer charges are calculated as 40% of the water charges.
- Residential garbage collection and landfill \$15.50 per month (increased from \$14.50 per month)
- Residential recycling collection \$4.00 per month (no change)


Town Council continues to follow the philosophy that all municipal utility operations must be paid for by the users of each service and not subsidized with general property taxes. In 2010 Stettler residents will continue to enjoy a high level of municipal utility services for an affordable combined monthly fee of \$43.50 plus \$1.77 per m³ of water consumed.

Town Council encourages all residents to use water wisely. 2010 Business Licenses are now due. All businesses in the Town of Stettler are required to obtain a business license for \$125.00 per calendar year. If the business is from outside the Town/County of Stettler corporation boundaries, the fee is \$325.00 per calendar year.

♥Sidewalk/Snow Removal Policy/Vehicles Removed From Streets**♥**

To help ensure <u>SAFE</u> and <u>CLEAN</u> sidewalks during the winter months, please clean your residential and commercial sidewalks as soon as possible after every snowfall. The Town Bylaw states that all snow and ice must be removed within 48 hours of the accumulation. Please make sure you sand or salt your sidewalks as well to ensure the safety of our citizens. **DURING SNOW REMOVAL, PLEASE ENSURE THAT YOUR VEHICLE IS REMOVED FROM THE STREET WHEN RESIDENTIAL STREET CLEANING SIGNS ARE POSTED**. Not having to work around vehicles will ensure a quicker response

time and a cleaner street. Also residents <u>MUST</u> remove their driveway curb ramps for the winter months. The Town will not be responsible for any damages Town equipment may cause during snow removal and street maintenance. Thank you for your co-operation.
