7. Regional Fire Chief Report

a) QMP revision status, 2016 QMP internal audit review

The Stettler Regional Fire Departments audit was approved, M. Dennis circulated a copy of the signed agreement.

The QMP has been signed by all, after Botha has been dissolved and included as the County an amendment will have to be made.

Fire investigation reports get audited as well.

Fire Works:

The Fire Safety codes have changed and the Fire Department will be required to collect fees for them. M. Dennis wondered if a bylaw should be written so the Regional Fire Department can could admin fees for processing permits as well.

There will also be new regulations for the sellers of Fire Works, a permit will have to be presented in order to purchase, a permit will have be obtained to discharge, you must be over 18 so ID will also have to be presented.

b) Medical First Response – Update

The Regional Fire Department will have to get a letter from the Town and County approving the Fire Department sign up for Medical First Response Training.

Y. Cassidy suggested the County mirror the Towns motion. Volunteers will have the choice if they want to train for Medical First Response or not.

c) Signage status for Villages, Hamlets and Rural Subdivisions

Signage is being upgraded.

Lorne has a Quote from Alberta Traffic Supply he will show to M. Dennis and Y. Cassidy will contact Lorne with what they have been paying at the County

d) Updated mapping information for Emergency Services use

Rich is updating the maps of the County M. Dennis asked the committee members from the Villages if they could get updated maps of their Villages, so M. Dennis can put hard copies in the trucks.

e) Major event planning – Alberta Prairie Tails and Trails

From June 28th to July 5th approx. 8000 people are projected to attend the Alberta Prairie Tails and Trails event.

E. Brugman will be heading up a meeting with the other emergency services and Rails & Trails to address and action plan. Rails & Trials should be responsible for the cost of contracting emergency personnel. Y. Cassidy suggested they contact the Stettler Ambulance Association to see if any of the casual EMT's might sign up to work and the 2 Ambulances on the bank might be available to be used as well.

f) Recruitment

Since Donalda suspended operations there has been some interest in volunteering. Plans are to hold a meeting at the Donalda Fire Hall to let people know what is required to be a volunteer Fire Fighter to spark some interest. The County Connection just came out with 3 pages dealing with recruitments, have posted on Face Book and other media sources.

- D. Richards cautioned Insurance companies could change their rating for Donalda residences to unprotected so something has to be done soon, Donalda is important and they need to be protected.
- B. Gartside asked if the EMR reimbursement is in the works, M. Dennis confirmed it has been submitted to be paid.

g) Training

Last year's class have all passed their practical training and have written the exam for their Level 1 just waiting on the results. This training speeds it up compared to the pass on the job training, volunteers can be certified much quicker. Next years will be put through the same training.

M. Dennis would like some kind of recognition for the ones being certified for Level 1 by Mayor Richards, Reeve Nixon, Town and County Councillors.
