Title: **Vehicle and Equipment Replacement**

Purpose: To ensure that all Town of Stettler equipment and vehicles are replaced in a consistent regular manner as required to maintain an efficient and effective work fleet.

Policy Statement:

- (a) All motorized and licensed light duty vehicles may be replaced upon accumulating 100,000 km per vehicle to a maximum of 10 years of age based on amount of use.
- (b) All motorized and licensed heavy duty trucks may be replaced upon accumulating 150,000 km per vehicle to a maximum of 10 years of age based on the amount of use.
- (c) Heavy duty equipment non-licensed may be replaced upon accumulating 5000 operating hours per vehicle based on usage and maximum life expectancy of 10 years before trade-off.
- (d) Light duty equipment (mowers, tractors, attachments) non-licensed may be replaced upon accumulating 3000 operating hours per vehicle based on usage, the maximum life expectancy of 5 years before trade-off.
- (e) Service equipment (pumps, weed eaters, push mowers, rototillers, sewer equipment, water equipment, tools, etc.) may be replaced as required at the discretion of Management.
- (f) Heavy equipment and motorized equipment can, at the discretion of Administration, be replaced prior to or later than the above designated years or hours.
