Hello everyone. Finally it would appear that the weather has taken a turn for the good. What a lot of cold and wind storms we have endured this spring.

Just a few things to report:

- We are very pleased to report that our application for water with Shirley McLellan Water Commission has been approved by Alberta Transportation's Water for Life Program. White Sand's total of \$1,434,500 of the project is 90/10 funded between the Government and the Commission. This amount includes \$150,000 towards a truck-fill station which is planned for near the flag pole at the Village entrance.
 - Lifts and docks have to go in the water every year or they cannot be stored on shore. We will move any which you are not using to your property.
 - We now have a WIFI hot spot near the hall parking lot. This is not for gaming or movies please as we have limited data. If this gets abused, we will have to remove it. The password is dfarb87372.
 - Please do not store boats, trailers, etc. on the road allowance.
 - Fire pits are not allowed on Village property. Please move them onto your own lots. Thank you for your cooperation.
 - Many thanks to the folks who are looking after our Village flower boxes.
 - The Maynards subdivision has been approved to develop 19 lots along Jennifer Drive. This development will include a summer store.
 - We are going to try a new dust control product in the Village on a half a kilometre on the boat launch road and a half a kilometre on Jennifer Drive to see how it works.
 - As the dog population continues to grow in the Village, please keep all dogs leashed or contained on your property.
