Dear Rate Payers,

As we leave behind this soggy spring, and look forward to the lazy hazy days of summer, here is just a little more information for you folks from your Council:

- Please do not park trailers or vehicles on the roadways where they might block Emergency vehicles. This is particularly important on long-weekends when there are lots of people and vehicles in the Village.
- The Ambulance and Fire Authority would like all of us to have contrasting colours for our house/cabin numbers or signs so we are easily identifiable. (I am in arrears on this myself).
- Beach grass has been planted to stop sand erosion. The Village will be harrowing by the water's edge so please do not groom this area yourself.
- Fire pits are not permitted on Village property. Please remove all fire pit areas including circles of rocks.
- The Stettler Transfer Station is opening a new garage for hazardous waste such as: old paints, batteries, toner, small electronics such as cell phones, florescent bulbs, household hazardous waste. It should be open in late summer.
- Trees on the beach have been temporarily flagged and will be marked with orange round disks to mark the anchors for the "no wake" buoys so they can be found in case the buoys come off. Please do not remove the disks.
- Enclosed is an information sheet about invasive mussels. Please read carefully, especially if you or your guests are operating your water craft in other bodies of water. This could be very detrimental to Buffalo Lake.
- The Annual General Meeting will be held on Saturday, June 29th at 9:00 am in the Multi-Purpose Building (Hall). Hope to see you there!
