Animal Trapping Program 2015

The Town of Stettler animal trapping program for cats will begin May 1st, 2015. Traps will be provided by Alberta Animal Services and rented with a rental deposit of \$20.00 that is held for the duration of the rental agreement along with a signed rental agreement. When the trap is returned at the end of the rental agreement in proper working order the deposit will be refunded. When an animal is trapped the trap must remain closed and secure until an Officer attends to service and pick up the trapped animal. All cats which are trapped are taken to the Alberta Animal Services impound facility in Red Deer where an owner is contacted or adoptable cats are taken to the Adoption Centre in the Red Deer Petland to find new homes.
