Development Standards

New subdivision requirements:

See (The Town of Stettler Municipal Development Plan)

Location hierarchy:

Design based on hierarchy of experiences starting with the best:

1. traveling through unspoiled environment
2. through manicured parks
3. on a boulevard of low volume roads
4. on a boulevard of high volume road
5. on a low volume road
6. on a high volume road

The Pathway plan should include the following elements

a) Connections:

1. Between important destinations and major residential enclaves.
2. directness between major landmarks and destination parks

b) Accessibility:

1. Non motorized transportation system which can accommodate walking, wheelchairs, cycling, in line skating and strollers.
2. All road crossings must be made at crosswalks or intersections

c) Signage/Identification
