Important Notice Regarding Garbage and Recycling Pickup

All garbage and recycling in Stettler will be picked up in front of residents' homes for the first time, in an effort to preserve the integrity of the lanes.

CanPak, the Town's contracted garbage service, picks up garbage in 22 communities. The Town of Stettler is the last community to make the switch to front street pick up due to the extreme snow conditions this season. The Town feels we have been successful in keeping the lanes passable to date, however with the recent warm weather, the lanes are quickly becoming impassable as garbage trucks leave large ruts in the lanes.

On their regular garbage and recycling collection days, residents are asked to set out their garbage or recycling in front of their homes instead of in lanes/back alleys. The Town of Stettler will route contracted garbage and recycling trucks through neighborhoods according to the usual collection schedule, but those trucks will avoid back lane pickup and collect garbage in front of homes. If you live on a corner lot that faces two streets, please ensure your garbage is placed on the street where the majority of homes are.

The transfer station, located on the northeast corner of Town, at 38 Street and 55 Avenue is also available for garbage missed on a regular collection day. Residents are asked to put the garbage out before 7am the morning of their regular pickup.

The garbage and recycling will remain in the front until the week of April 14, 2014. If you require additional information, please call the Town Office at (403)742-8305.
