The Stettler Community Orchard project is well underway. We'd like to thank all of the many generous donors that have stepped up to support this project, as well as all of those people that have helped out in some way over the course of this project. Phase 1 of the orchard has been prepared and planted with approximately 1500 fruiting trees, shrubs and perennials. Soon there'll be lots of green plants visible all over the site and there will be vines growing on the lattice fence. There are some finishing touches that we're working on to make the site more educational, which will be completed over the summer. We are planning an official "launch" event in early September to recognize donors and to celebrate this accomplishment.

In the meantime, we continue to push ahead in our fundraising efforts, so that we can complete Phase 2 this summer and next spring. Phase 2 includes 3 different fruiting species, as well as a bunch more flowers, plus a drip irrigation system for both phases.
