## Building a FENCE?

Do you need a permit? According to the Town of Stettler's Land Use By-law 1976-08 Section 15 a Development Permit is not required for:



The construction or maintenance of gates, fences, walls or other means of enclosure less than 1.22m (4 ft.) in height in front yards and less than 2.0m (6.56 ft.) in height in side and rear yards except where corner lot restrictions apply.

Please note it is the owner's responsibility to ensure that fence construction does not encroach past the property line. If you have any questions please call the Town Office at 403-742-8305.

## Building a SHED or DECK?



Do you need a permit? According to the Town of Stettler's Land Use By-law 1976-08 Section 15 a Development Permit is not required for:

The construction or installation of an accessory building that does not exceed 9.5 m<sup>2</sup> (102 ft<sup>2</sup>) in area and 2.5 m (8.2 ft) in height, provided that the structure is portable and not fixed on a permanent foundation or concrete pad; and construction of an unenclosed deck that does not exceed 15 m<sup>2</sup> (162 ft<sup>2</sup>) in area. Please note it is the owner's responsibility to ensure that the shed or deck does not encroach into the setback requirements for an accessory building. 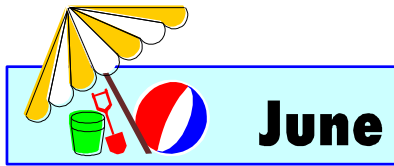
## Stettler Town & Country Museum

## Fire Pits & Outdoor Fireplaces

The Town of Stettler permits fire pits and outdoor fireplaces ONLY with the following requirements:

- A minimum of 3m (10 ft.) clearance shall be maintained from buildings, property lines or any combustible material.
- Installations shall have enclosed sides made from bricks, concrete blocks, heavy gauge metal or other suitable non-combustible components.
- A spark arrestor mesh screen or 1/2" expanded metal (or equivalent) to contain sparks shall be provided over the fire.
- Only clean fuel shall be used (clean, dry wood or charcoal). Refuse or waste material shall **NOT** be burned.
- The use of such installations shall ensure that smoke or sparks do not create a nuisance or hazards to neighbors or other properties and comply with the Clean Air Act.

**ALL FIRE PITS MUST BE EXTINGUISHED WHEN RETIRING AND NEVER LEFT UNATTENDED!**

## Municipal Enforcement Services

The Town of Stettler is reminding all residents that there is no parking of any unattached trailers or campers on the streets at anytime. If you leave your trailer or camper unattached on the street it may be ticketed and towed. There is also a maximum of 24 hours permitted to park an RV or attached trailer on a street for loading and unloading.
