Building a FENCE?

Do you need a permit? According to the Town of Stettler's Land Use Bylaw 2018-11 Section 15 a Development Permit is not required for:

The construction or maintenance of gates, fences, walls or other means of enclosure less than 1.22m (4 ft.) in height in front yards and less than 2.0m (6.56 ft.) in height in side and rear yards except where corner lot restrictions apply.

Please note it is the owner's responsibility to ensure that fence construction does not encroach past the property line. If you have any questions please call the Town Office at 403-742-8305.

Building a SHED or DECK?

Do you need a permit? According to the Town of Stettler's Land Use Bylaw 2018-11 Section 15 a Development Permit is not required for:

The construction or installation of an accessory building that does not exceed 9.5 m² (102 ft²) in area and 2.5 m (8.2 ft) in height, provided that the structure is portable and not fixed on a permanent foundation or concrete pad; and construction of an unenclosed deck that does not exceed 15 m² (162 ft²) in area or does not measure more than 0.76m (2 ft.) from grade. Please note it is the owner's responsibility to ensure that the shed or deck does not encroach into the setback requirements for an accessory building.
