Would you remember all your loved one's medications, allergies and past medical history if all of a sudden you needed an ambulance? Starting May 1, 2011 Town of Stettler residents can pick up capsule of life information as part of a free program sponsored by Stettler District Ambulance and Savage Drugs at the Town of Stettler office. An information sheet is filled out at home, placed in a specially marked medicine vial and placed in a prominent place in the fridge. Small stickers are provided for the outside doors to let the EMS Crew know the owner is a participant of the program.
