



Sidewalk Care

Keeping sidewalks clear of ice and snow can be very challenging through the winter. De-icers that contain salt can be a valuable tool to remove ice, however their over-use can cause spalling and damage to concrete. The ideal time to use salt and de-icers is when temperatures are higher than -10 degrees Celsius. Please ensure that once a melt starts to occur, the salt is shoveled off the concrete to prevent damage. Also be aware that the salts placed on the sidewalks, end up washing into the storm system and end up in Red Willow Creek. There are alternate products available that provide traction on slippery sections and are available at retailers in Town.

Private Property Snow Removal

Alberta Animal & Municipal Enforcement Services Officer Kevin Duval would like to remind Town residents about snow removal procedures. Please ensure the sidewalks and driveway entrances on all sides of your house are cleared of any snow within 48 hours of the initial snowfall to assist other residents as they commute. Also, please obey the Snow Removal signs which may be placed in your area and move your vehicle to another location for the time period stated. The snow removal signs will be placed in your area at least 12 hours in advance to advise all residents in the area that the Town will be clearing snow. Your cooperation will greatly assist the Town employees to clear any snow from your area.
