Stettler & District FCSS

Invites eligible projects to submit funding proposals by October 24, 2008.

Eligible/Non-Eligible Projects

Section 2 of the Conditional Agreement Regulation (Alberta Regulation 218/94) provides direction for program funding. It states that:

In providing for the establishment, administration and operation of a program it must:

1. Promote, encourage and facilitate the involvement of volunteers.
2. Promote efficient and effective use of resources.
3. Encourage and facilitate cooperation and coordination with allied service agencies operating within the municipality.
4. Promote, encourage and facilitate the development of stronger communities, and
5. Promote citizen participation in planning, delivery and the governance of the program and of services provided under the program.

Services provided under a program must NOT:

1. Provide primarily for the recreation needs or leisure time pursuits of individuals.
2. Offer direct financial assistance to sustain an individual or family.
3. Be primarily rehabilitative in nature, or
4. Duplicate services that are ordinarily provided by a government or government agency.
