Municipal Election

Remember to vote on **October 18, 2010** from 10:00 a.m. – 8:00 p.m. at the Stettler Community Hall (located at 5101 – 46 Avenue) for election of Town of Stettler Mayor & Councillors. Two candidates are running for the position of Mayor being Dick Richards & Will Brown and eleven candidates for Councillor who are eager to serve on Town Council being Darcy Bachman, Al Campbell, Malcolm Fischer, Dave Garbutt, Boyd Jackson, Len Kostenuk, Wayne Tebbe, Dave Thiessen, Leona Thoroughood, Peter Simons & Steven Wildeboer. A person is eligible to vote if he/she is: at least 18 yrs old, a Canadian Citizen, has resided in Alberta for the six consecutive months immediately preceding election day and is a resident in the local jurisdiction on election day. Every voter shall subscribe to a declaration in the form prescribed by the Minister that he/she is eligible to vote and a voter is eligible to vote “only” at the voting station for the voting sub-division in which he/she resides.
