*Remember to vote on **October 19, 2009** from 10:00 a.m. – 8:00 p.m. at the Stettler Community Hall (located at 5101 – 46 Avenue) for election of Town of Stettler Councillor. Three candidates for Councillor are eager to serve on Town Council being Darcy Bachman, Trent Cottom and Sherry Larter. A person is eligible to vote if he/she is: at least 18 yrs old, a Canadian Citizen, has resided in Alberta for the six consecutive months immediately preceding election day, is a resident in the local jurisdiction on election day, every voter shall subscribe to a declaration in the form prescribed by the Minister that he/she is eligible to vote and a voter is eligible to vote “only” at the voting station for the voting subdivision in which he/she resides. The **Advance Vote** will be held in the new Town Office Board Room (located at 5031-50 Street) on **October 14, 2009** from 10:00 a.m. – 2:00 p.m.*
