However at the end of the 2014/2015 season the Stettler Curling Club experienced a total loss of \$11,768.59. Following is the breakdown:

- Total Operating Expense - \$99,977.60
- Total Operating Revenue - \$59,573.38
- Total Operating Loss - \$40,404.22
- Minus - 2014/2015 Bonspiel Profit - \$15,636.88
- Minus - 2014/2015 Lounge Profit - \$10,954.05
- Minus - 2014/2015 Raffle Profit - \$2,044.70
- Total 2014/2015 Loss - \$11,768.59

The major expense was repairs to the ice plant. This summer the compressor in the ice plant was replaced for a cost of \$39,000 which was taken out of our general savings account.
