a. Banners & Signage:

b. Communities in Bloom

Chairperson Rob Spencer stated that the school is going to apply for the Agrium grant. Chairperson Rob Spencer also advised that we need to reserve the rooms for the Communities in Bloom Judges and to talk discuss the awards for the banquet. Chairperson Rob Spencer stated that he spoke to Mr. Fleishchhacker at the High School about having a student video tape the Communities in Bloom tour this year. Chairperson Rob Spencer said that he is going to work on the profile book for the Judges.

c. Environmental Action Sub-Committee

Councillor Steve Wildeboer spoke of having the recycling awards at the yearly Board of Trade awards night. Grace Fix suggested that the winners of the recycling award should be given Heart of Alberta Dollars. Gerry Little suggested that the winners have the choice of keeping the Stettler dollars or donating them to an Organization or Business as a donation.

Some students will be coming to help lay the mulch down and Rob Spencer stated he is planning to do a launch of the new Community Gardens to recognize the TD Bank for the grant that we received.

Gerry Little suggests that we get new planters or paint the existing planters we have placed around the Downtown area to update them because they look very industrial.

Grace Fix suggested we do a train theme on the planter's.

Councillor Steven Wildeboer thinks we should go with the whiskey barrels instead of painting cause it's cheaper and will look better. Councillor Peter Simons and Chairperson Rob Spencer agreed. Sue-anne Hennessey questioned whether the whiskey barrels would be tall enough.

"Eliminate paper towels"



Eliminate the use of paper towels. A staggering **14 billion pounds** of paper towels are used by North Americans every year – that's around **140 million trees for single-use paper towels**. When you factor everything to make paper towels or napkins (harvesting the tree, processing and bleaching the material, packaging it, shipping it, driving to and from the store to purchase it, etc.), paper towels and napkins are about twice as energy-intensive and create more greenhouse gases than cloth. Plus, paper towels are used **ONCE**...cloth can be used for years. Instead of using paper towels, consider old towels or rags you have around the house which you can wash and reuse time and time again. If paper towels are a must, choose those made from 100% recycled materials.
