Title: Control of Clubroot Disease in Canola

<u>Purpose:</u> To allow the County of Stettler No. 6 Pest Inspectors to set the control measures to be used against Clubroot in Canola crops within the Town of Stettler.

Policy Statement:

The Town of Stettler recognizes that Clubroot of Canola is a serious pest problem and supports the principle to control the spread of Clubroot which has been declared a pest under the Agricultural Pests Act. Under the Pest Control Act it is a responsibility of a local authority to prevent the establishment of, or to control or destroy pests in a municipality.

Procedure:

The Town of Stettler will follow and adhere to the Agricultural Policy 2.4 "Control of Clubroot Disease in Canola" policy set out by the County of Stettler No. 6 and appoint Pest Inspectors annually in accordance with the "Agricultural Pests Act", Revised Statutes of Alberta 2000 Chapter A-8.
