Title:                      **Street Sweeping/Road Grading**

Purpose:                      To implement a Street Sweeping and Road Grading System that is effective, efficient and economical.

Policy Statement:

A. General                      It will be the policy of the Town of Stettler to start a street sweeping program in the spring as soon as the weather permits.

All main routes will be given a thorough cleaning first.

After this is done the Town will be broken up into five divisions:

1. 50<sup>th</sup> Street West to 57<sup>th</sup> Street.
2. 50<sup>th</sup> Street East to 42<sup>nd</sup> Street.
3. 57<sup>th</sup> Street West to 62<sup>nd</sup> Street.
4. Highway #12 South to 44<sup>th</sup> Avenue - Plus Parkdale and Parkland Meadows.
5. Grandview Stages 1 - 4 Plus Spruce Village.

B. General                      The Town will undertake two major sweeping routes as follows:

Downtown Business core, street sweeping to be bi-weekly except the 2<sup>nd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> week which is to be done on Tuesday morning only.

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The east industrial paved roads to be done bi-monthly in the 2<sup>nd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> weeks on Friday mornings.

All paved business parking lots will be swept once per year on request courtesy basis.

It will be the policy of the Town of Stettler to start a grading program each spring as soon as weather permits.

That priority will be given first to roadways (classified as streets or avenues) then second to laneways and finally to parking lots.

All gravelled public parking lots in the Town which are privately owned will be graded once per year on a request basis at the Town's expense.
