HOLIDAY TRAILER PARKING REQUIREMENTS:

To keep our community safe and accessible for all residents, please be mindful of the following parking regulations:

- **Time Limit Parking:** Where signs are not posted, the parking time limit shall be 72 hours.
- **Unattached Trailers:** No person shall park any trailer upon any road unless the said trailer is attached to the vehicle. Additionally, the slides must be in and the jack must be up.
- **Trailer Occupancy:** No person shall occupy or suffer or permit any other person to occupy a trailer upon a highway or upon public property
- **Trailer parking on Private Property:** No Trailer may be parked on any property unless it is wholly contained on a driveway or parking pad



REGISTER TO VOTE!

Under new provincial legislation, all eligible voters who wish to vote in the upcoming election must be listed on the Permanent Electors Register. Registering in advance will ensure your voting experience is as smooth as possible creating a faster process to cast your vote. **Voters need to register (or check their existing registration) on www.voterlink.ab.ca by August 31** to be included on the Electors Register. Non-registered voters will be required to complete registration at a voting station prior to casting their vote.
